


added courses which creates awareness about Environment and inculcates Moral and Ethical values in the young minds of the students.

The rate of courses offered in each semester and the relevance to real life applications have especially been appreciated by the students. Less than 2% have rated the parameters as Average and .5% as Poor. The rate of offering of electives sees some variation but within the categories of Good or Very Good. The majority of the students, are of the opinion that the course would help them prepare for competitive examinations and for higher studies.

ALUMNI FEEDBACK- ON CURRICULUM

The alumni feedback was satisfactory since many of them are well-placed or pursuing higher education. Several want to return to the institution as research scholars. The alumni feel that the curriculum offers them an advantage in pursuing higher. They feel that the constant updating of the syllabus was in keeping with the changing real-life applications. The alumni were also looking forward to interacting with the current students through alumni online talks such as were held during the academic year.

PARENTS' FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

Several parents appreciated the handling of the classes and the conduct of the examinations during the pandemic. The parents were satisfied with the curriculum as it is relevant to the current scenario. Nearly all the parents marked the parameters as Excellent, Very Good or Good. There was a suggestion that the students, especially in the first year, could be helped to communicate better in English. No parent had marked the parameters as Average or Poor. The ambience of the college, the rate of outcome, rate of the courses in terms of their

relevance to the latest technology were highly appreciated, being mostly marked as Excellent. The parents were happy with the syllabus, quality of the courses included in each semester, allocation of the credits and evaluation. Most had marked the treatment of the students by the teaching faculty as Good or Very Good. All the parents expressed their confidence in the quality of the curriculum in helping secure good jobs or higher education opportunities for their wards.

FACULTY FEEDBACK

The feedback from the faculty members was highly encouraging with more than 95% strongly agreeing that the Board of studies ensures that relevant courses are offered in the programmes, the curriculum has been designed by giving weightage to employability, enough freedom is given to contribute ideas on curriculum design and development, the ideas provided by the Subject Expert and University Nominees enhance the design of the curriculum, representation from Alumni, business and industry inputs are helpful and that the curriculum has been updated as per the needs of the stakeholders. The Certificate and Add-on courses are considered an advantage but the faculty wanted some more courses.

EMPLOYERS' FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

The employers were satisfied with the knowledge and skill level acquired by the students through their curriculum. They were especially appreciative of the soft skills and communicative proficiency of the students. They stated that the syllabus matched the industry requirements but recommended that more exposure should be given to the students in the form of internships.
