The Chairman welcomed the Computer Technology board members for the implementation of the syllabus for the students admitted in the academic year 2017-2018. The Chairman then briefed the activities to be taken up by the board for the implementation during the year 2017-2018. The following actions are implemented based on the feedbacks collected from all the stakeholders.

ITEM 1 : To approve the rules, regulations and syllabi for the students of B.Sc(CIT) for the academic year 2017-2018.

The Chairman presented the details of the Curriculum, syllabi and Schemes of Examination prescribed for B.Sc(CIT) courses. The Board recommended and approved the following changes in the syllabi prescribed for the students to be admitted in the Academic year 2017-2018

### B.Sc Computer Technology :-

- \* In Semester I C programming paper is revamped by adding Introduction of Computer programming in Unit I
- \* To revamp the syllabus of Digital fundamentals and Computer organization in Semester II
- \* To modify the list of practical programs in C++ programming lab in Semester II
- \* To modify the syllabus of Data structures and Analysis of algorithms in Semester III
- \* To revamp the syllabus of Relational database management systems in Semester IV
- \* VB.Net programming paper is renamed as .Net framework and the syllabus also revamped in Semester IV
- \* To change the practical title "Vb.net and Oracle lab" into ".Net framework and Oracle lab", the list of practical programs are also modified in Semester IV
- \* To revamp the syllabus for the paper Computer networks in Semester IV
- \* To revamp the syllabus of the <sup>paper</sup> Software Engineering and testing in Semester V

\* To Introduce the paper "mobile computing" Instead of client Server techniques in Semester V.

\* To Introduce the paper "PHP" Instead of web programming in Semester VI

\* To Introduce the practical paper "programming lab - PHP" Instead of web programming lab in Semester VI

\* To Revamp the syllabus of Information security in Semester VI

### Elective papers:

The Elective papers for fifth and sixth semesters are

- (i) Network Security
- (ii) cloud Computing
- (iii) System software
- (iv) client Server techniques.

ITEM 2 : To Suggest a panel of question paper setters.

The Board approved the panel of question paper setters for B.Sc(CT).

ITEM 3 : To Suggest the panel of Examiners for theory, practicals and Viva-Voce Examinations was prepared and approved by the Board.
